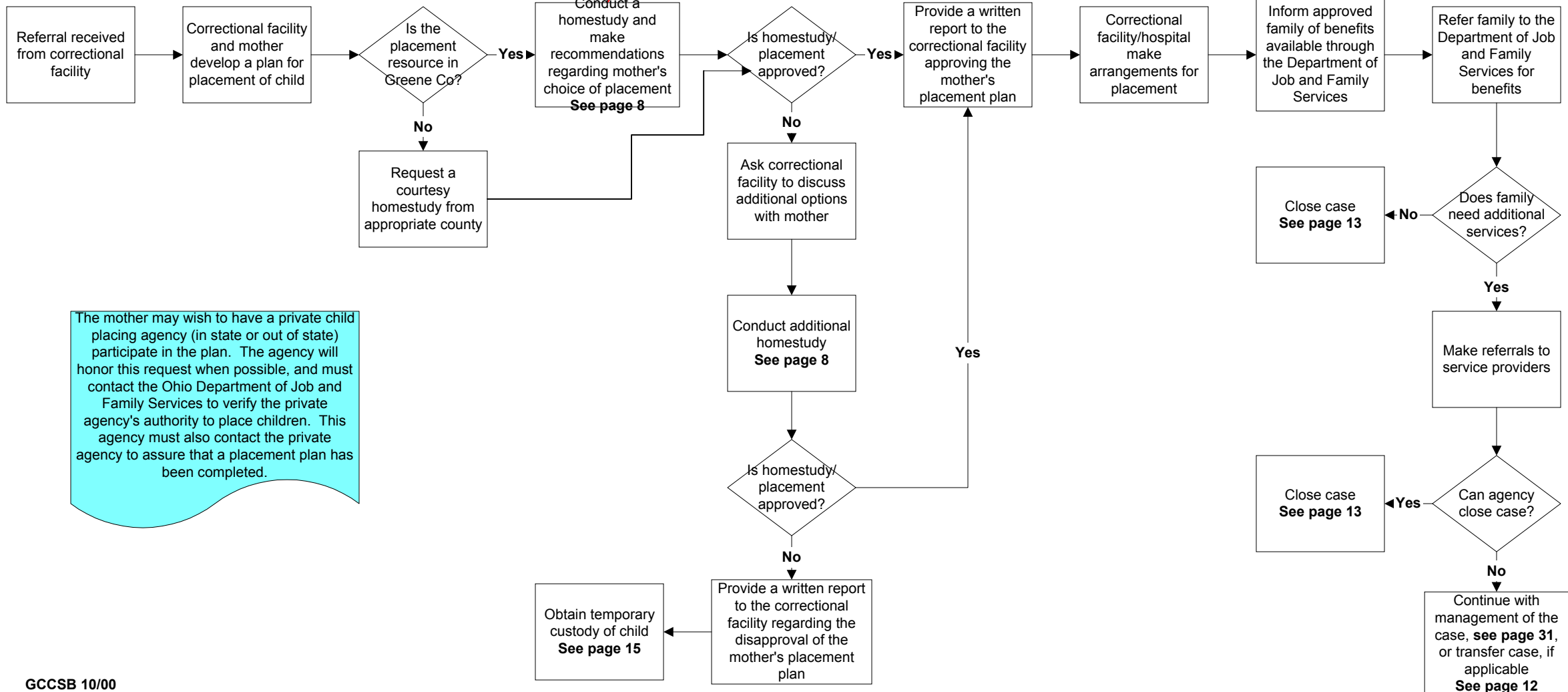


# Postnatal Placement Services to Infants of Incarcerated Mothers

For further information see Ohio Administrative Code Rule 5101:2-42-60

This procedure is applicable when a female from Greene County is incarcerated and is due to deliver a child or has delivered a child. The female identifies a possible placement plan and this agency is responsible for an investigation and recommendation regarding whether or not the placement plan arranged by the mother provides for the infant's care and safety. In these situations, the county of residence at the time of conviction and sentencing shall be the responsible agency. In the event that there was no Ohio county of residence, the agency in the county in which the woman was convicted and sentenced shall be the responsible agency.

Can the placement plan arranged by the mother provide for the care and safety of the child?



The mother may wish to have a private child placing agency (in state or out of state) participate in the plan. The agency will honor this request when possible, and must contact the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services to verify the private agency's authority to place children. This agency must also contact the private agency to assure that a placement plan has been completed.
